The goal of the Watercraft Inspection Program is to inform and educate the public on the threats of ecologically harmful aquatic invasive plants and animals to the Chisago Lakes Chain of Lakes. The watercraft inspector works at public water access sites educating the public by providing information to watercraft users and conducting a brief survey while inspecting watercraft for invasive species.

Chisago County has formed a partnership with the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources to conduct boat launch inspections.
